NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ADOPT AN AMENDED CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Minter Field Airport District intends to adopt an amended conflict-of-interest code pursuant to Government Code Section 87300. Pursuant to Government Code Section 87302, the code will designate employees who must disclose certain investments, income, interests in real property and business positions, and who must disqualify themselves from making or participating in the making of governmental decisions affecting those interests.

A written comment period has been established commencing on November 19, 2020 and terminating on January 3, 2020. Any interested person may present written comments concerning the proposed code no later than January 3, 2020 to the Minter Field Airport District, Attention Jonathan Hudson, 201 Aviation Street, Shafter, CA 93263. Please note that no public hearing on this matter will be held unless an interested person, or his or her representative, requests such a hearing no later than 15 days prior to the close of the written comment period.

The impetus for the adoption of this Code is the age of the former code. The Minter Field Airport District has prepared a written explanation of the reasons for the designations and the disclosure responsibilities and has available all of the information upon which its proposal is based. The adoption of the Code will not impose a cost savings to the District that is required to be reimbursed under Part 7 (commencing with section 17500) of Division 4 of the Government Code; will not result in any nondiscretionary cost or savings to local agencies; will not result in any cost or savings in federal funding to the state; will not impose a mandate on local agencies or school districts; and will not have any potential cost impact on private persons or businesses, including small businesses. No alternative considered by the District would be more effective in carrying out the purpose for which the action is proposed or would be as effective and less burdensome to affected private persons than the proposed action.
